KYB Overview

(2rd – 6th Grades)

The **2nd & 3rd grade program** is focused on introducing kids to the fundamentals of basketball and will run from early November to late January. Our 3rd grade teams will NOT play a competitive league schedule or have any scheduled games but we will try to set up a scrimmage or two with other 3rd grade teams from the area.

The **4th-6th grade programs** are focused on developing skills and participating in a competitive league environment. 4th-6th grades will run from early November to late February/early March. Teams will play approximately 16 league games (games are on Saturday mornings/early afternoons) against teams like Campbellsport, Eden, Lomira, Laconia, Oakfield, Mayville & North Fondy. Each team will also participate in the League tournament which usually takes place in late February. Uniforms will be provided.

**Teams typically practice 2 evenings per week in District gyms.
The days and times of practices will be dependent upon gym availability.**

Kewaskum Eagles (Boys) & Tribe (Girls) Overview

(For 7th & 8th Grades)

We also have programs designed for 7th and 8th graders that gives kids the opportunity to play above and beyond our Middle School program in a competitive tournament environment. These programs are designed to be a bridge between the Middle School and High School programs where participants will continue to develop their skills but also learn more about the philosophies and systems being run at the Varsity levels here in Kewaskum.

The Eagles program is available to BOYS in 7th and 8th grades and will be run by Joel Fleischman with input from the H.S. boys program.

The Tribe program is available to GIRLS in 7th & 8th grades and will be run by Doug Vlotho with input from the H.S. girls program.

The Eagles and Tribe programs will NOT conflict with the Middle School basketball seasons. Depending on numbers, teams may institute try outs and cuts. Unlike KYB, playing time is not guaranteed for Eagles & Tribe participants. Our Eagles & Tribe teams typically play in tournaments starting after the Holidays. The cost of participating in these programs will be determined by the number of participants and the costs associated with the number of tournaments that we play in (the cost gets distributed evenly to all players). Uniforms will be provided.
